## Start of 3rd postgraduate course in CE



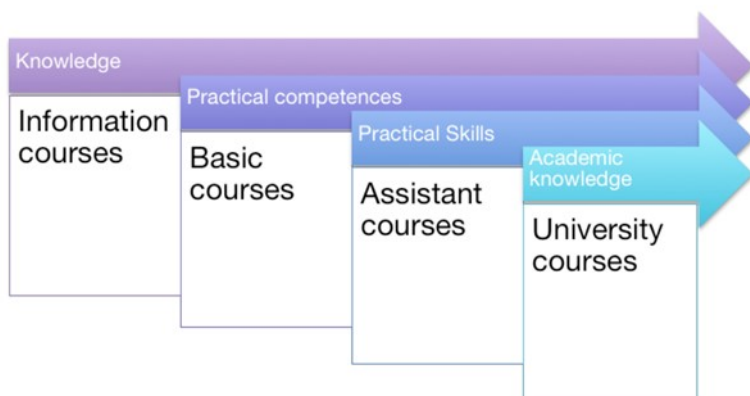

We are very pleased to inform you that the 3rd certificate course in CE at the University of Vienna has started at the end of March 2022. 21 students from various conductive and curative education institutions in Austria and Germany participate and will learn conductive, pedagogical, therapeutic contents during two semesters. Aim is to integrate the newly acquired knowledge into their practical work. The course is organised in 4 blocks of lectures and will be performed live, online and hybrid. The beginning took place in Vienna in close cooperation with the Institute Keil GmbH. In May the participants come to Bavaria. Lectures and observations of practice are organised in the Conductive Centers of Pfennigparade Phoenix Schulen und Kitas GmbH and Fortschritt Bayern GmbH. The 3rd block in autumn is offered online - the students come together in local learning groups. Finally the last block takes place in cooperation with Haus KOMET eV of R. Albers, Psychologist, on the Northern Sea.

Internships in various institutions, knowledge checks and an intensive theory-practice-transfer round off the course. Subsequently, graduates of the certificate course can participate in the Master's program of CE (MSc) at Danube University Krems.

## Maria Król: Helping disabled children from Ukraine!

Dear Friends,

Due to the escalating refugee crisis, during which 2 million refugees have already entered Poland, including thousands of people with disabilities and their families, the Association has taken on a number of new challenges. / Since February 28th we have been making our facilities available, created at the expense of limited space for our Polish participants, for short-term stays of disabled Ukrainians after they cross the border. / We provide rest, food, clothing, necessary medical and social assistance, etc. and facilitate finding destinations and transportation to them. / We also collect/purchase food, medicine, hygiene items, etc. and forward them to Ukraine. / But now the time has come to take the next step in helping refugees with disabilities and their families. In Poland there are not enough long-term places for them to stay, and the societies of Western Europe and the world have not been open enough so far to accept refugees, especially people with disabilities (with their families). We are still looking for new possibilities. / For the most part, families of people with disabilities, given the inconvenience of distant travel, declare their desire to stay as close as possible to the Polish-Ukrainian border. They also hope to return quickly after the war is over and Ukraine is rebuilt. / Poland will be forced to create settlements for refugees. / Our Association, responding to the needs of disabled refugees and their families, is determined to create for them long-term accommodation in adapted conditions.

We have at our disposal large plots of land with access to electricity and water (next to our centres) in Białobrzegi 57 near Zamość (2 hectares) and in Bondyż near Krasnobrod (2.64 hectares), where we could quickly build living containers and supply them with electricity, water and sewage. We have considerable material resources (equipment) and human resources (over 300 employees and volunteers). We are raising funds to help refugees from Ukraine, from which we would be able to maintain the operating costs of this infrastructure and all costs of functioning. / Obtaining a grant or donation would enable us to purchase and install (along with supplying electricity, water and sewage) appropriate, adjusted, heated containers equipped with bathrooms. / The estimated cost of a container for 2 families with disabled people and a shared bathroom (the most economical version) is more than 60 000.00 PLN. / With this request, the Association appeals to many communities in Poland, Europe and the world, hoping to create a housing container settlement thanks to international solidarity. / We will put country/donor names on the houses. We hope there will be many! / Once the war is over and Ukraine is rebuilt and the refugees have returned to their homes, the infrastructure of the settlement will be used to house adults with disabilities from Poland who are struggling with homelessness and lack of care after the death of their parents/guardians.

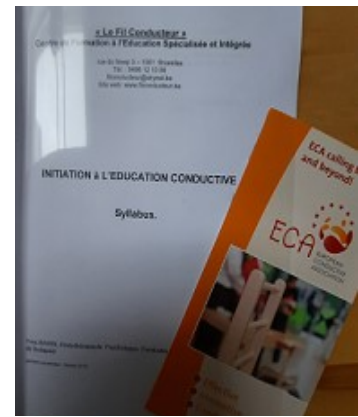
